

Guide for Financial Aid

Two options are available to assist families in financing a student's Salpointe Catholic education. You can apply for both options, but you can only accept one option. **You cannot combine Option 1: ESA and Option 2: Financial Aid, STOs or Tax Credits.**

Option 1: Empowerment Scholarship Account (ESA) Program

The Empowerment Scholarship Account (ESA) program is an account administered by the Arizona Department of Education and funded by state tax dollars to provide educational options for qualified Arizona students. By opting out of the public school system, parents can seek a range of alternative educational services, such as private school or home-based education. Empowerment Scholarships are funded at 90 percent of the state's per-student base funding. In 2023-2024, Empowerment Scholarships are worth about \$7,500. Apply online at https://www.azed.gov/esa

Option 2: Financial Aid, Scholarship Tuition Organizations (STOs) and Tax Credits. These can be combined/stacked together.

Apply online to Financial Aid Independent Review (FAIR) at www.fairapp.com. Awards for the 2023-2024 school year range from \$1000 to \$6000. This award is based on financial needs.

Please fax or upload a copy of your 2022 tax return as well as 2022 W-2s or your final paystubs for 2023 for income verification. Salpointe will send award notifications for those who meet the January 19 deadline by the end of February 2024. Late applicants will receive notification in June 2024.
